Please remember that all these fixtures are subject to change up to and including the Monday before games are due "Spare" indicates that a League Match Secretary has currently been unable to assign a fixture for the side concerned, but they may well be able to assign one as and when adjustments occur. A side shown as "spare" should be prepared to have a fixture assigned

- Match Confirmation** Would all Clubs please note that match confirmations to opposition & referees should be undertaken by the Club Match Secretary or Secretary and NOT managers, captains etc as this leads to confusion on details on venue, ko times etc.
- Members Services** Details on using Members Services can be found on the AFC website. Members Services gives club officers and referees access to various county held information relevant to them and their football, and should be an invaluable administrative tool to help them with their day to day management of football. See the website for more details.
- Fixtures/Results Bulletins** Clubs, Officers and Referees are reminded that where possible, we wish to send this fixtures bulletin, the results and league tables via email. Clubs and League Officers who require the bulletins to be sent by post have to pay an extra £25 for the season. This does not apply for referees (but if you have email, please let us know so we can save clubs the cost).
- Reporting Results** Scorelines continue to be reported by SMS text message this season, and this now includes all games, including county cup fixtures. Note that the requirement to include the word RESULT at the start of text messages has been removed.
Please note that the results of penalty shootouts for cup games should be reported on the SMS text message AFTER the full-time scoreline, i.e. 2-2 5-4 reports that the match finished 2-2, and the home team won 5-4 on penalties.
- Match Day Returns** Please refer to detailed guidance document on website and sent in pre-season post out (with handbooks). Old CRS form is no longer acceptable - all match day marks to be entered directly on Full Time asap after the match.
- Referee Marking on FT** Would all administrators of the FT system please ensure that when marking referees they mark out of 100 max. (NOT 10). Any mark less than 61 requires a report to be sent to the Referees Secretary within 7 days as per Rule 13h.

If the referee on FT is not the referee who actually refereed the match or is a Club ref please enter referees name and score in the last box on the team marks tab. IF YOUR REFEREE IS THE APPOINTED REF PLEASE DO NOT ENTER MARKS OR NAME OF REFEREE IN THIS BOX - ENTER THE REFS MARK AGAINST HIS NAME AT TOP OF PAGE

Referees - You Can't Have Enough!

Do you know of any referees who might wish to join the Amateur Football Combination? Do you have a club referee who might wish to register with the league - even if you intend to keep serving your club only? Are you a player who referees occasionally, or might move into refereeing and is interested in qualifying to become a referee?

If any of the above apply to you - please contact the Acting Referees Sec, Stan Rosenthal, for more information. We want to attract and support as many referees as we can to the league, and the more we have qualified and registered the better.

Fixture Secretaries

Please note the importance of ensuring you confirm your home fixtures with both the opposition and the appointed referee not later than the Monday preceding the game (ie 5 days before the game is due). Any Club failing to comply with this shall be fined by the Fixtures Committee under rule 10d and are liable to lose their appointed referee to another game.

Away clubs **and referees** are reminded of the importance of making sure such games are confirmed as well. If the home club is unable to contact you and is leaving messages for you, please have the courtesy to call them back immediately.

Home Fixtures

If a club has too many/too few home fixtures, then your first port of call should be opposition fixture secretaries. The League Match Secretaries will have no objection to clubs switching venues for fixtures as long as the referee is in agreement and the LMS is informed. Clubs are advised to try and do this as soon as fixtures are published.

Postponements/Match Secs

Clubs are reminded that if a league or cup match is postponed the League Match Secretary should be informed as soon as possible and not later than 9pm on the **DAY OF THE MATCH**. If the postponed match is a Cup Match then please ensure you also inform the appropriate officer from the Cup Competition concerned. These phone calls are essential and in addition to reporting results by the usual methods.

Postponements/Referees

When a match is postponed the home club should inform the opposition as soon as possible. If the referee has been appointed by the league, then please contact the appropriate regional Assistant Referees' Secretary (Alex Grayburn or Chad Chaudhuri), and the referee. They will also contact the referee and may well be able to assign him to a different game. Clubs must ensure they **speak** to Alex, Chad or Stan - do not leave a message. Please note this **only** applies to officials appointed by the league.

It is the responsibility of the club to confirm postponements:- by speaking to Alex, Stan or Chad, and the referee directly. Clubs are reminded that cancellations also need to be reported to the appropriate League Match Secretary.
